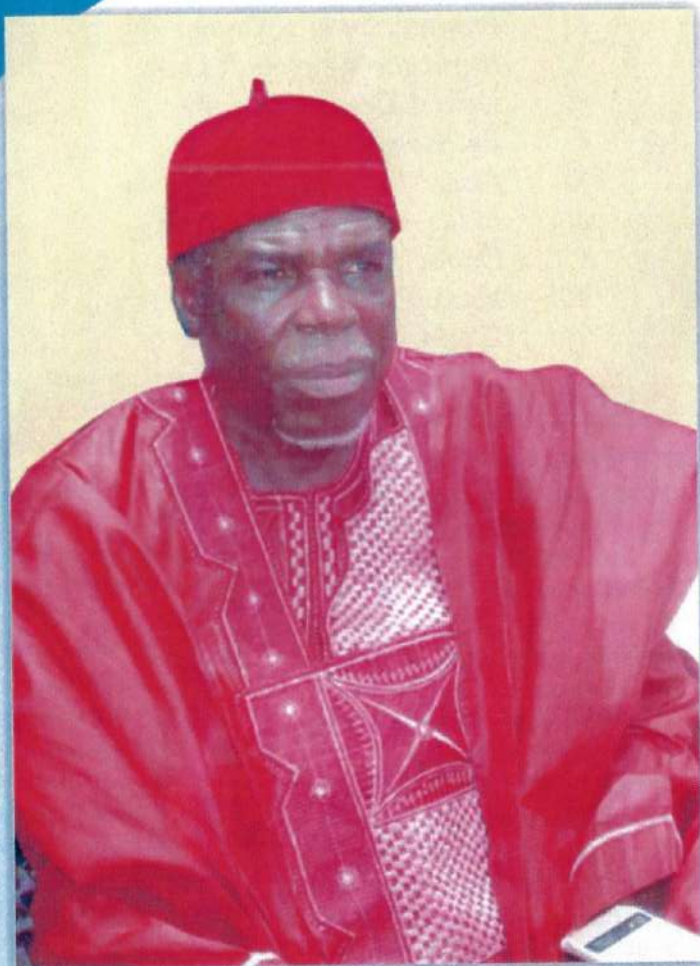

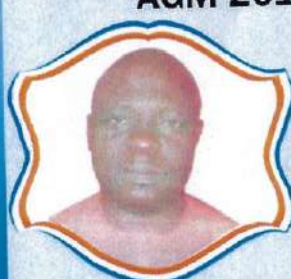

Thomas Chukwuma Makwe was born on 4th April 1949 at Kaduna by Mr P.C.O. Makwe and Mrs Cecilia Nwachukwu Makwe(Nee Ezeadiefe) natives of Asaba.

He attended various Primary Schools and finally finished his Primary School Education at the, then Roman Catholic School No1 Warri.

He attended Mater Dei College Ashaka and Ika Grammar School Agbor from 1962 to 1970 and obtained his O and A levels certificates under the Nigeria civil war condition which was very serious at Ashaka, Agbor and Asaba at that time.

After his higher school education at Ika Grammar School Agbor he taught Mathematics, Geography and Economics at Saint Patrick's College Asaba from 1970 to 1972 when with the guidance of Honourable Justice Chike Idigbe JSC of blessed memory, he gained admission into the University of Nigeria and read Law at Enugu Campus from 1972 to 1976

He was called to the Bar as a Barrister and Solicitor of the Supreme Court of Nigeria on 2nd July 1977.

He had his compulsory one year National Youth Service Program in Bauchi State between 1977 and 1978

before he settled for Private Legal Practice from 1978 to 1992.

He was appointed a Delta State High Court Judge on 21st October 1992 and was sworn in on 20th November 1992. He was latter loaned to the Federal Government of Nigeria as a Judge of the Miscellaneous Offenses Tribunal Lagos from 1996 to 1999.

As a Delta State High Court Judge he served a total of 22 years in various Stations which are Kwale, Warri, Ughelli, Otu-Jeremi, Isele-Uku and Asaba. He retired meritoriously from the Delta State Judiciary on 4th April 2014 due to the 65 years constitutional retirement age.

He married his precious wife Mrs Veronica U. Makwe(Nee Okafor) and they are blessed

with many children.

He is also very kind and nice to people. He is a philanthropist and a benefactor in his own little way.
